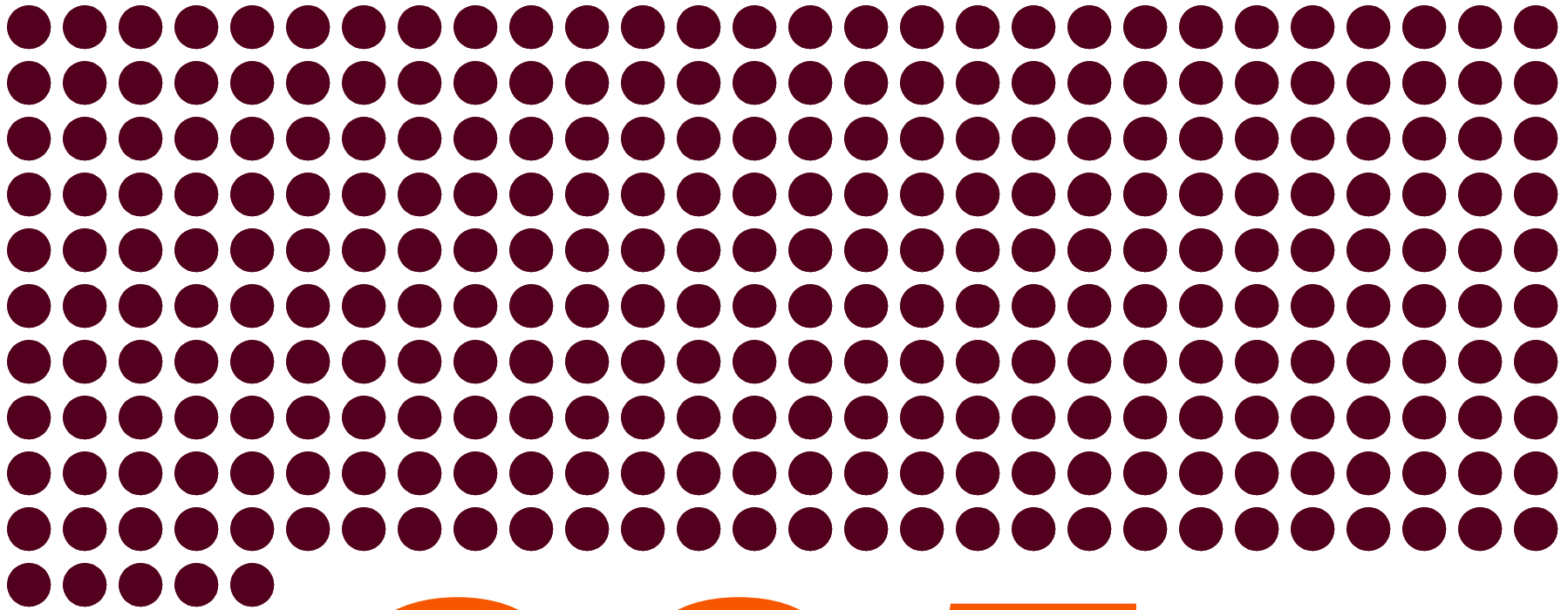

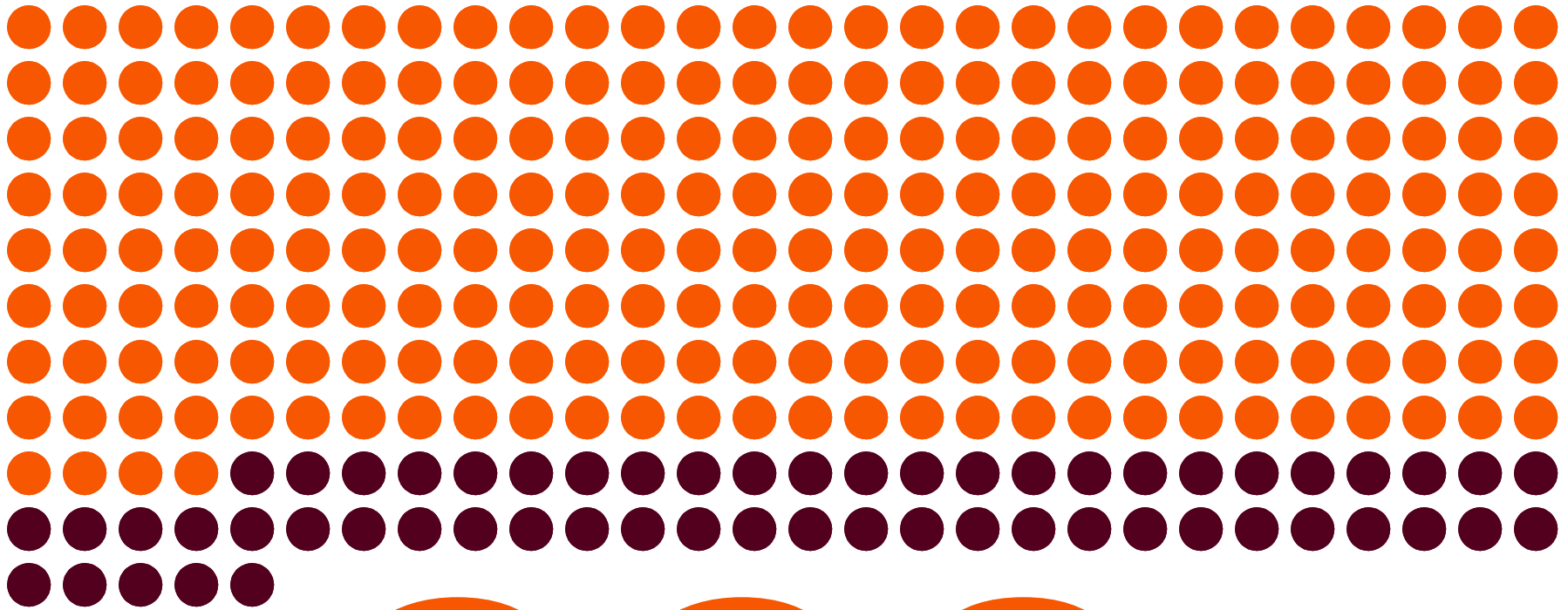
Global Blindness Facts

- 39 million blind/246 million visually impaired
- Leading causes: **cataract and refractive error**
- 80% of blindness is **avoidable**
- 90% of blind live in **low income countries**
- 2 out of 3 blind people are **female**
- **1.4 million are children**

- Today: 25 partner hospitals
- In 2014 this network served over 5 million patients

Soor Aur Saptak™* Children's Eye Fund

- **2013 - \$6,417; 2014 - \$11,798, 2015 - ~20K**
- By January 2015 surgery for 244 kids
 - congenital cataract (44)
 - traumatic cataract (35)
 - developmental cataract (26)
 - corneal perforation/ulcer (29)
 - other cases: strabismus, pediatric glaucoma, retinal detachment, cancer, pseudophakia, etc.
- Fund reserves for 100 more
