Seva Foundation Overview

Seva is a global nonprofit eye care organization that transforms lives and strengthens communities by restoring sight and preventing blindness. We train local eye care providers and develop self-sustaining eye programs around the world. Together we provide critical eye care to underserved communities, especially women, children, and indigenous peoples.

Seva has helped nearly 4 million blind people regain their sight in more than 20 countries. 39 million people in the world are blind. 80% of them could see again with your help. 2 out of 3 people are female, and the leading cause is cataract. In India, 7.8M are blind, 63M are visually impaired, and 400,000 are children. Restoring sight is one of the most effective ways to relieve suffering and reduce poverty.

Soor Aur Saptak™ Overview

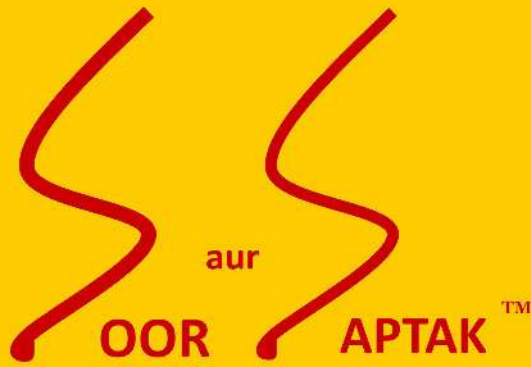

It's main goal is to support Seva's programs through Soor Aur Saptak™ Children Eye Fund to prevent pediatric blindness. This fund has zero overhead which means every cent goes towards helping blind children.

This is all possible because of kind and generous support from so many. A large number of dedicated and motivated volunteers donate their selfless effort and time.

The entire Portland community comes together with a common purpose and a vision that "giving vision to a blind or visually impaired child opens tremendous opportunities for the young life, provides prospects to become a productive citizen or whatever the child wants to be, get educated, and lead a normal family life we all just assume." This is our sixth year in existence. We raised a modest \$6.5K in the first year and over \$26K last year.
